

Doctor Di Giambenedetto was born in Rieti, the 26th September 1972.

She obtained the baccalaureate in Classical High School at Rieti's Liceo Classico "Marco Terenzio Varrone" in 1990-91 with an evaluation of 60/60. She has attended the faculty of Medicine and Surgery at University of Sacred Heart of Rome since the year of study 1991-92 and she graduated the 17th of March 1998 with the evaluation of 106/110.

She obtained the title of specialist in Infectious Diseases the 10th of November 2003 with the evaluation of 50/50 cum laude.

From June 2004 to December 2008 she worked as a MD with a contract at the Institute of "Clinical Infectious diseases" at Policlinico Gemelli. Since January 2009 she has worked as a Clinical Researcher at the Institute of "Clinical Infectious diseases" at University of Sacred Heart of Rome, Policlinico Gemelli.

Doctor Di Giambenedetto's research activity takes place activity at the Institute of "Clinical Infectious diseases" at University of Sacred Heart of Rome and is predominantly focused on HIV infection, opportunistic infections in AIDS and antiretroviral therapy.

- Adherence to antiretroviral therapies.
- Mycobacterial infection diagnosis in the course of HIV infection
